

School Council Community Code of Conduct

The Community Code of Conduct indicates the way the school interacts with the local community. Hampton Park Primary School acknowledges that the parents, children and other residents of the neighbourhood area are important members of the school community.

Therefore:

- The school will obtain advice and support for its programs through consultation and collaboration with the community.
- The rights and confidentiality of community members will be respected.
- The school will offer a welcoming environment to the community.
- The school will ensure that the demands made upon local resources are always reasonable.
- The school will ensure that staff and students using community facilities and resources will do so with care and respect.
- The school community will be kept informed of school activities through a weekly newsletter, press releases to local newspapers, a published annual review of its performance, the school's Web page on the Internet and an annual community meeting.
- The school will undertake regular reviews of its performance to determine the level of community satisfaction.

The school expects that members of the community will:

- treat staff, students, parents and other community members with courtesy, sensitivity and fairness;
- provide their students with materials, clothing and equipment necessary for effective day to day activities;
- actively support and participate in school activities where possible;
- give appropriate information to teachers where necessary;
- make effective use of the school's communication systems to keep themselves informed of, and show interest in, what is going on in the school;
- maintain confidentiality regarding information about students and teachers, which has been obtained whilst working at the school; and
- while assisting on excursions, camps, classroom and other activities, community members have a duty to supervise the students in their care adequately so that the students are protected from risk or injury.
